Dr Fred de Looze has a considerable background in general practice and primary care research and teaching both nationally and internationally. He has been Director of the Inala Health Centre General Practice Clinical Trials Unit, undertaken Supervisory and Principal Investigator roles in a number of phase II – IV drug Clinical Trials at the Brisbane South Clinical Research Centre and the Princess Alexandra Hospital, across a range of medical conditions as well as national and international outcomes based trials. He retired as the Director of the Inala Health Centre General Practice and Inala Health Centre General Practice Clinical Trials Unit in August 2006 after 13 years of service and is now Principal of Trialworks Clinical Research Services. He remains involved in Clinical Trials with the Princess Alexandra Hospital.

Dr Fred de Looze is a Senior Lecturer in the Discipline of General Practice, School of Medicine, University of Queensland, and has previously taught as a Senior Lecturer in General Practice at the Royal Free Hospital and School of Medicine, London, UK.
