



Mr. Ian Donaldson

Board Position: Director

Ian Donaldson has a significant professional background that consists of commercial board appointments, government appointments and services to the community. His services to the community include joining the Leukaemia Foundation of Queensland (LFQ) in 1983 to become its honorary Treasurer, and then honorary President in 1990, a position he held until 2003. In 1995, Ian was instrumental in influencing LFQ to form the Leukaemia Foundation of Australia to seek opportunities for expansion across Australia. Ian became the Leukaemia Foundation of Australia Inaugural Chairman 1995-2002. Ian was also Chairman of the Advisory Board of the Australian Centre of Philanthropy and Non Profit Studies at Queensland University of Technology

Ian Donaldson is a Fellow of the Institute of Chartered Accountants in Australia and has served in many honorary positions such as: member of Queensland State Council of the Institute of Chartered Accountants (1992-1999), Queensland Chairman in 1996-1997, National Council of the Institute in (1996-1997), Chartered Accounts Advisory Committee, and numerous Institute committees. In 2002, Ian was awarded the Meritorious Service Award of the Institute of Chartered Accountants in Australia for his services to the Institute and the profession.

In his career as a company director, Ian has been on the board of five companies listed on the Australian stock exchange:

- (i) Queensland Metals Corporation, which became Australian Magnesium Corporation Limited 1983-1996 (minerals exploration, mining and research)
- (ii) Norminco Limited, which became Virotec International Limited - Deputy Chairman 1994-1997 (tin mining in North Queensland)
- (iii) City Pacific Limited, where he has been Chairman since 1997 (funds management and investment banking)
- (iv) CP1 Limited, where he has been Chairman since 2002 (property development)
- (v) Indigo Pacific Capital Limited, where he was Chairman 2004-2006 (equity investment in property development companies).
