725	<p><b>Review of a GPMP</b></p> <p>Review of a previously performed detailed plan of care for a patient with a chronic disease. Involves goal setting and has a clinical and patient orientated focus.</p>	Every six months	\$65.30
727	<p><b>Review of a TCA</b></p> <p>Review of a previously performed referral method used to refer a person on a GPMP to at least 2 allied health professionals (it requires 2 way communication with the allied health professionals regarding the patient.) Patient then receives 5 Medicare rebated visits to these professionals in a calendar year.</p>	Every six months	\$65.30
10997	<p><b>Service provided to a person with a chronic disease and a GPMP by a Practice Nurse</b></p> <p>Education of or assistance provided to a patient with a GPMP by a practice nurse.</p>	Five per patient per year	\$11.10
11506	<p><b>Spirometry</b></p>	Any time that it is done	\$18.95

Involves clinical information and assessment of daily living activities.</p>	<p><b>Every three years and not within three years of a 45-49 year old health check</b></p>	<p><b>\$61.40</b></p>
714	<p><b>Health Assessment for refugees</b></p> <p>For a newly arrived refugee. Medical component normally performed by those practices undertaking refugee health services.</p>	<p><b>Once within 12 months of arrival in Australia</b></p>	<p><b>\$208.70</b></p>
717	<p><b>45-49 year old Health Check</b></p> <p>For a person in this age bracket who has a predisposition to a Chronic Disease. Involves clinical information and assessment of daily living activities.</p>	<p><b>Once only (not within three years of a 713)</b></p>	<p><b>\$104.55</b></p>
718	<p><b>Health Assessment on a person with an Intellectual Disability</b></p> <p>A comprehensive health assessment (involving the Carer) of a person with an intellectual disability. Involves clinical information and assessment of daily living activities.</p>	<p><b>Annually</b></p>	<p><b>\$208.70</b></p>
900	<p><b>Home Medication Review (HMR or DMMR)</b></p> <p>An assessment of medications and the way the patient uses the prescribed medication for a person whom has five or more medications or whom it is deemed appropriate. This assessment involves an accredited pharmacist reviewing the medications and sending a report back to the GP.</p>	<p><b>Annually</b></p>	<p><b>\$140.20</b></p>

700	<p><b>Health Assessment over 75 Years</b></p> <p>A comprehensive health assessment for a person in this age bracket. Involves clinical information and assessment of daily living activities.</p>	Annually	\$175.10
704	<p><b>Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Adult over 55 years Health Assessment</b></p> <p>For any indigenous person in this age bracket. Involves clinical information and assessment of daily living activities.</p>	Annually	\$175.10
10987	<p><b>Follow up service for an Indigenous person who has received a health check. The service is consistent with the needs identified through the health check</b></p> <p>May be used to provide :</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Examinations/interventions as indicated by the Health Check;</li> <li>• Education regarding medication compliance and associated monitoring;</li> <li>• Checks on clinical progress and service access;</li> <li>• Education, monitoring and counseling activities and lifestyle advice;</li> <li>• Taking a medical history; and</li> <li>• Prevention advice for chronic conditions, and associated follow up</li> </ul>	Maximum of 5 services per patient in a calendar year.	\$22.20
