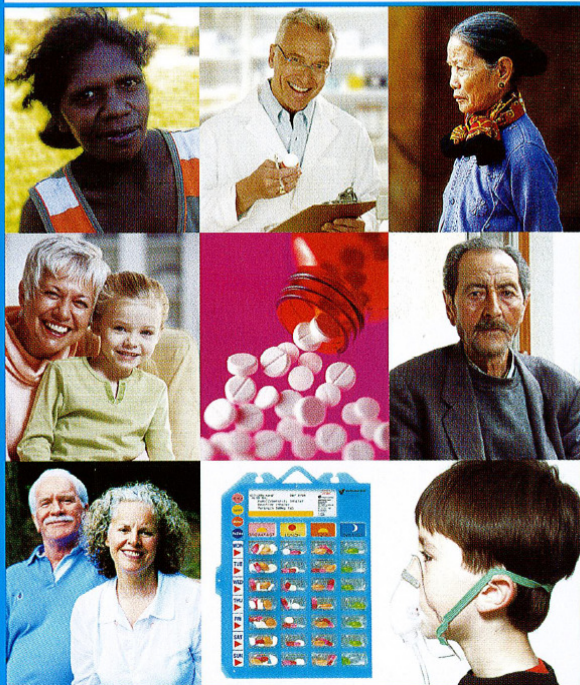


MANAGE YOUR MEDICINES, MANAGE YOUR HEALTH

Talk with your GP at your next visit.



WHAT ARE HOME MEDICINES REVIEWS?

A Home Medicines Review (HMR) is a way for your GP and your pharmacist to help you manage your medicines at home. When you visit your GP, ask about a HMR. If you and your doctor agree that a HMR may help, a referral will be sent to your pharmacy and your pharmacist will make an appointment to see you. A follow up appointment with your GP will be required to discuss the HMR.

CAN HMR BENEFIT YOU?

Can you answer 'yes' to any of these questions?

- Are you confused or worried about your medicines?
- Do you sometimes forget to take your medicines?
- Do you see more than one GP or specialist?
- Have you recently spent time in hospital?
- Do you take complementary medicines?

If so, it might be a good idea to ask your GP about a Home Medicines Review.

ARE THERE ANY CHARGES FOR HMR?

If your GP bulk bills, then there is no cost to the consumer. The Australian Government provides the funding to help you achieve better medication management.
